- 2016-2017 Strategic Plan Adopted

- Influence Public Policy to support Virginia nuclear workforce needs
  - Energy cluster
  - Expanded community college energy/nuclear training certificates
  - Career Day for key high school, community college, and university faculty—Q1 2017
  - Nuclear job links on VNEC website



- Continued support for Center for Advanced Engineering and Research—help find matching money for legislative appropriation
- More DOE, NRC, et al. nuclear research dollars into Virginia universities and facilities
  - New reactor research potential
  - Coordination with DOE, Office of Nuclear Technology
  - Increased coordination within the Virginia research and nuclear business community



- Increased congressional advocacy on nuclear issues
  - Impact of plant closures on Virginia suppliers
  - Role of nuclear generation in meeting clean air goals
    - Importance of successful license extension for Virginia nuclear plants
